A SUBSIDY SCHEME BY THE HONG KONG SAR GOVERNMENT



To support the gradual resumption of business events and strengthen the city's reputation as a premier international convention and exhibition hub, the Hong Kong SAR Government has launched a venue rental subsidy as part of the HK\$1.02 billion Convention & Exhibition Industry Subsidy Scheme under the Anti-epidemic Fund.
